THE ADAMIC COVENANT pt 2

The Adamic Covenant is the first expression of God's everlasting covenant.

- The everlasting covenant is the completion and all inclusive covenant God made with Himself.

God made 6 covenants with me and 1 with Himself.

- He made the everlasting covenant concerning me, not Himself.

Why would God make a covenant with Himself concerning me?

- Because I am made in His image and likeness.
- You will not be cast away unless you willfully reject Him.

Genesis 1:26 | NKJV

26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth. **27** So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion.

Here is the first revelation of this covenant. *Be fruitful, multiply, etc.*

The **Promises** in the Adamic covenant.

- Be fruitful
- Multiply
- Fill the earth
- Subdue it (authority over Satan)
- Have dominion (reign)

THIS COVENANT STILL STANDS TODAY!

- God says, "here is My first covenant."

With every promise comes terms.

The **TERMS**:

- Don't eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

What's He saying here: "*Don't try to be God. Don't try to dethrone Me.*"

Q: Where was the blood of this first covenant?

- It came from Adam himself.
 - God opened his side - that's where her blood came from.

- You cannot open someone's side without blood shed.

Q: What happened with the Last Adam, Jesus?

- His blood flowed from His side.
 - His wife was taken from his side and the church(His bride) was born.
 - When they opened His side the covenant was sealed.

(That's Genesis 2:18-25)

Genesis 2:21-24 | NKJV

21 And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. **22** Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.

23 And Adam said:

“This is now bone of my bones
And flesh of my flesh;
She shall be called Woman,
Because she was taken out of Man.”

24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

She is bone of his bone, and flesh of his flesh.

- You cannot have flesh and bone without blood.

We are bone of His bone and flesh of His flesh.

- We come from Christ Jesus.

That tells us that the first bride and bridegroom is the revelation of redemption.

Ishah - woman of the womb; she womb

- Woman means: “womb man” - out of my own womb/body
- Womb = life; being

She is bone of man's bone, flesh of his flesh.

We are bone of His bone, flesh of His flesh.

- We come from Christ Jesus.

The first bridegroom is the revelation of redemption of Jesus and His church.

The Mediator in the first covenant was God Himself.

5 promises in the Adamic covenant.

- Be fruitful
- Multiply
- Fill the earth
- Subdue
- Have dominion

This is yours NOW!

Jesus gave this to us and the power over it. We reign.

- Rev 1:6 We are a king and priest.
- We reign with Christ now.

- The devil is not the authority.
- We are.

When asked: "What is the one thing you could tell the church before you die."

"No nation is stronger than its spiritual forces."

All the powers nations possess means nothing, only the power of the church.

- I have power in my mouth.
- God said, "I have put my Word in your mouth."
- Authority - "whatever you say."
- Problem: we don't believe it.

We have no idea how powerful God's Word is in your mouth.

- There is no power in the words of a man outside of the covenant.
- If you are a man of the covenant what you say will happen and the devil will not be able to stop it.

Faith teaching goes back to the first covenant.

5 promises in the Adamic covenant.

- Be fruitful (no poverty)
- Multiply
- Fill the earth
- Subdue it
- Have dominion

The terms are: "Don't try to be God."

The **SEAL**

- You'll seal it by having access to the tree of life.
- Satan came and before man could execute the covenant of God and tempted the woman.
- Adam did not keep the terms.
- Satans purpose was an attack against the covenant to break mans relationship with God.
- God created man to sit on the throne that Satan once possessed.

Lucifer had fallen and he could not be trusted anymore.

- And that covenant is promised and still in tact.

Satan drives a wedge between God and His creation and destroys their relationship.

- He tempts the woman as an attack on the covenant.
- Adam broke the terms and ate of the fruit.

That covenant was not cancelled even though Adam did not keep the terms.

- Man never sealed it.
- When Adam would reach out and touch the fruit of the tree of life, he would seal the covenant.
- He broke the terms when he ate the forbidden fruit.

Had Adam touched the fruit of the tree of life he would still be alive today and we would be lost.

- That's why God put guards over the tree of life after they sinned.

Even though the Adamic covenant was put on probation... in grace and mercy He offered to them restoration.

So now, He's going to give them new promises with new terms.

- These did not replace the original promises.
- These were additional promises.

5 promises in the Adamic covenant.

- Be fruitful
- Multiply
- Fill the earth
- Subdue it
- Have dominion

Terms: Don't touch the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

So this covenant had **Promises, blood** but no **seal**.

God said, "Even though Satan attacked our covenant, I'm going to offer you restoration."

God gives an additional promise in Genesis 3

Genesis 3:15 | NKJV

15 "And I will put enmity
Between you and the woman,
And between your seed and her Seed;
He shall bruise your head,
And you shall bruise His heel."

In that promise of restoration in the Adamic covenant we see God's promise for redemption and the destruction of Satan.

- In Genesis 1:26-28 there was not a promise to destroy Satan in the covenant before, now there is.
- God gave 5 promises and added 2 to make it 7.

#6 - **He shall bruise your head,**

- Satan will be destroyed

#7 - **you shall bruise His heel.**

- Man shall be redeemed

2 were added to the Adamic covenant.

NEW TERMS:

- Believe, have faith, and trust Me.
- I will do what I said I would do.

God is saying:

"I will empower you with faith so you won't break it again."

- Satan attacked the covenant saying "eat the fruit."
- Now the faith of God was in Adam.

God is saying, *"I will do everything I said I would in these promises, all you have to do is believe me."*

- And here we see faith first introduced in the Bible.
- It was not first introduced to Abraham.
- It was introduced to Adam first.

Surely you can keep the terms of the second covenant.

That is where you get the word: **Eve**

Genesis 3:20 | NKJV

20 And Adam called his wife's name Eve, because she was the mother of all living.

In other words: she was the mother of believers, not unbelievers.

- Mother of the faithful, not the unfaithful.
- When she was called Eve, Adam declared his faith in the redemption of what God had promised.
- She is the mother of all living - **the mother of all the redeemed**.
- Eve does not mean the mother of all humanity, that is a declaration of faith.

Adam was declaring man's redemption.

God called her "Adam" meaning "earth," but Adam called her "Eve" meaning "heaven."

Adam = mud

Eve = mother of all living

Now, God sheds blood again.

Genesis 3:21 | NKJV

21 Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made tunics of skin, and clothed them.

- We see the shedding of a substitute.
- When God made the Adamic covenant the blood of Adam was shed but when he failed the blood of a substitute was shed.
- God provided an acceptable covering (substitution).
- In this blood sacrifice (first animal to be slain) God seals the covenant which was when Adam accepted the blood of another.

Seal = token.

- Every time you apply to blood you seal the covenant.
- Every time we receive communion we are sealing the covenant.

Every time you say, "I apply the blood of Jesus," you are executing the covenant. (Sealing it)

When I say “the blood of Jesus” I bring all its power into focus.

- In that sealing is a release of His power (the Holy Spirit).

Adam & Eve accepted the covering as a seal.

- They told their children about it, that’s why Abel knew how to offer a sacrifice of blood.
