## REVIEW

In these 7 Covenants we see the divine purpose of God for humanity.

The Bible reveals that God is a:

- Covenant-maker
- Covenant-keeper
- Covenant-revealer
- Covenant-enabler

Covenant require 3 things:

**Promise** - life comes to you

**Blood** - work is done for you (cross)

**Seal** - Word begins in you (requires a response - Isa 1:19) The Holy Spirit executes the covenant.

Our response to the covenant determines what we will receive.

## THE ADAMIC COVENANT pt 1

**Genesis 1:26** | NKJV

26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth. 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

When God created man and woman He called them both "Adam."  
The woman was not called Eve until after they sinned.

**Genesis 5:1-2** | KJV

1 This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; 2 male and female created he

them; and blessed them, and called their name **Adam**, in the day when they were created.

This clearly states that God first called the woman Adam.

- He gave this name to both male and female.
- God made His covenant with both.
- God did not make His covenant with the man only.

**Romans 8:14** | NKJV

**14** For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are **sons** of God.

*(Male sons and female sons)*

He said, "Let them have dominion."

He didn't say, "Let him have dominion."

**Genesis 1:26** | NKJV

**26** Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; **let them** have dominion...

The covenant was made with "Adam" (man and woman).

- In the garden before the entrance of sin - revealing His purpose in creation.

## **THE IMPORTANCE OF NAMES TO GOD**

1 Chronicles - God lists all the names of Israel's leaders, servants, etc.

He called us by name.

- The antiChrist system is a number system. That's the devil's system.
- God's system is a "name system."
- You are not a number to God... He knows us by name.
- They give prisoners numbers. It's the devils system.

Name means He identifies with you.

God calls His children by name.

- He knows you.

That is why He is jealous over you...

## **THE "WHY" BEHIND CREATION**

Genesis 1 & 2 not only record the creation but the reasons why God made them.

God created the earth as the house for His ultimate creation.

- He did not create the earth for the animals.
- God didn't create the heavens for the sun, moon, and stars.

He created the earth for a habitation for Adam and his seed.

We were never separated in promise.

- When He said, *"Let them have dominion"* He included His creation.
- His one creation - one revealed in two (male/female).

When God created woman He took her out of man so the two of them would be one.

- God didn't make two, He made one.
- There was still one in His eyes.
- So when He said, "seed" He included the woman.

God never called her woman, He called her Adam.

Man called her woman and man called her Eve.

(There is a beautiful reason why he called her Eve that has to do to redemption)

So God created the earth as a "house" for humanity.

- He created the earth, the animals, and then His masterpiece: man.

All of God's purposes were centered on man and in man.

- The animals were called to serve God's ultimate creation.
  - Sin destroyed all that.
  - But, it will all be restored one day.

So, God's purposes were centered in man.

- His revelation was in man and to man.

The Adamic covenant was to reveal God's purpose in creating man.

- It was the first expression of God's purposes.

No angel is created in God's likeness or image, man is.

- Everything was for man.
- **We are God's focal point.**

Angels were created with a free will just like us.

- They have the liberty of choice, that's why some chose to follow Satan.
- They were not created as robots.
- Billions of angels are lost with no plan of redemption. Why? God's purposes are not revealed to or in angels.

We are a privileged creation.

God's intent in creation is too vast for us to understand with our minds, they are too finite. (*Eye has not seen, ear has not heard*)

- God's purposes for you is beyond explanation.
- One day will know it and that's why we will cry "Holy, Holy, Holy!"

There is a book years ago written by a Satanist.

- Satan revealed to this writer what heaven was like for him.
- Satan told this man to write this book and to tell the people how boring it is to worship God.
- Of course there is no purpose to worship for Satan. Why? Because there is no love. There is no redemption.
- No angel can say or hear, "I love you."

- But we can.

Here is the biggest thing: He says that to us.

Angels have no relationship, fellowship, intimacy with God.

They have never prayed to God.

There is no covenant either.

- Not one place in the Bible did God make a covenant with angels.
- But with you, He made a covenant.

So, angels can fall.

Our great high Priest is not an angel, He is a man. JESUS.

- It's amazing that after Jesus prayed the angels came to comfort Him, but they couldn't pray with Him.
- Angels can carry the prayers of the saints to God but they can't pray for the saints.
- No covenant.
- They are a different creation.

Lucifer, an angel who was perfect in all his ways, never had a covenant with God.

- That's why when he turned against God there was no redemption.

So when you hear a preacher say, "One day Satan will be saved," that's called heresy. Demonic teaching.

- There is no covenant so how can there be salvation?

The reason salvation was offered to us is because there is a covenant.

- God made a covenant with man.

God's covenant is binding, it's forever.
