All of God's covenants are eternal.

- The Bible is a covenant book.

The Bible reveals God as a:

- Covenant-making
- Covenant-keeping
- Covenant-revealing
- Covenant-enabling God.

God will not deal with those who are NOT in covenant with Him.

- We made a covenant at salvation and that's why God deals with us.
- Outside the covenant He won't although He is a merciful God.

A covenant is binding, eternal, and has:

1. Promises / Terms
2. Blood
3. Seal

NOAHIC COVENANT

Made with Noah after the flood involved all creatures and future generations.

- It confirmed the Adamic Covenant and it revealed God's purpose seen in the Adamic Covenant.
- Adamic Covenant - man was put on probation. Now, he must trust God.

Between Adam and Noah we see a period of probation.

- The human race became divided into two groups: the obedient, and the disobedient.

Obedient - seed of Seth (Abel was killed)

Disobedient - seed of Cain

God said to Adam - *"Your trust in Me will seal the Adamic Covenant."*

By the time Noah came on the earth there were two races of people:

- The Godly
- The unGodly

Genesis 5:1-3 | KJV

1 This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; **2** male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

3 And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:

Seth - righteous line.

4 After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters. **5** So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died.

Adam lived a long time and had many sons and daughters.
- That's where Cain got his wife from.

Genesis 5 line of the righteous.
Genesis 4 line of the unrighteous.

Though man was under the law, or dispensation of conscience, the law of sin drove him away from his covenant God.

God offers Adam a covenant under creation.

The **Promises** in the Adamic covenant.

- Be fruitful
- Multiply
- Fill the earth
- Subdue it (authority over Satan)
- Have dominion (reign)

Terms: Don't touch the tree of the knowledge of good and evil

Seal: Eat of the tree of life

Adam broke the terms.

God came to restore the covenant by offering redemption.

New Terms: Put your faith be in Me.

Adam became a man of faith - evidence is in Abel: "by faith he offered a more excellent sacrifice than Cain."

- He understood his blood covenant through his father Adam.

Cain rejects the covenant God
Abel receives the covenant God
God rejects Cain
God receives Abel

The one rejected kills his brother -
Now, the line of the ungodly begins in Cain.

Adam calls his wife "Eve" - mother of the redeemed, not the unredeemed.
She conceives a son, Seth, the father of the Godly, replacing Abel.

Between the Adamic and Noahic Covenant we see the world becomes two groups:

- Line of Cain
- Line of Seth

Though man was under the law, or dispensation of conscience, the law of sin drove him away from his covenant God.

There are **7 Dispensations** (or laws) in the Bible. God works in dispensations.

1. **Innocence** (From Adam to Cain)
2. **Conscience** (from Cain to Noah)
3. **Government** (from Noah to Abraham)
4. **Promise** (from Abraham to Moses)
5. **Law** (from Moses to Jesus)
6. **Grace** (we are in it now)
7. **Judgement** (return of Christ)

Though man was under the dispensation of conscience.

- By now he knew what was right and wrong.
- Sin drove him away from his covenant with God.

Cain rejected the covenant.

- When he offered fruit instead of blood.
 - God is a covenant God, so when blood was offered there was a covenant made.
- He did not want to worship a covenant God.
 - That's the difference between the world and you.

You do not serve a God, you serve a covenant God.

- You cannot serve Him without making a covenant with Him.
- He is the originator of the covenant!
 - He said to Adam, Noah, Abraham, and Israel, "*Before you can walk with Me you must accept My covenant.*"
 - The covenant is the blood of Jesus.

God heals unbelievers because of mercy.

He heals believers because of covenant.

- Everything that comes through covenant we get to keep.

The unbeliever receives the left-overs.

Matthew 15:22-27 | NKJV

22 And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed."

23 But He answered her not a word.

And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us."

24 But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

25 Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!"

26 But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs."

27 And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table."

- The woman said, "I'll take the crumbs."
 - Many unbelievers are living on crumbs and think it's the real bread.
 - The bread belongs to the children.
 - All of God's promises are yours.
 - The unbeliever will get the crumbs and walk away from God.

The crumbs are still available, that's why they still get healed.

The people of the covenant are living a holy life.

The people who are not of the covenant it's all words.

- It is impossible for a covenant man/woman to have a demon.
 - Why? The blood is there and the blood and demons cannot inhabit the same place.
- True Christians have no devils.
 - If you have truly made a covenant with God you are totally free from Satan.

Why did Satan tempt the woman in the garden?

What was he trying to do? BREAK THE COVENANT.

He cannot get in where there is a covenant.

- He was after the covenant and he is still after the covenant.
- The devil doesn't really care for you. You're just another name, another face to him.
- He's got millions under his domain, he wants to destroy the covenant.

THE PEOPLE WHO ARE NOT IN COVENANT WITH GOD BELONG TO SATAN.

- People who have made a covenant with God - it is impossible for them to belong to Satan.

Cain's rejection of the covenant and murder of his covenant brother led to the corruption of the entire human race with one exception: **Noah**.

Gen 4 - Gen 6

The days of Noah:

- Inter-marriage
- Wickedness
- Evil
- Corruption
- Violence

This failure to keep the covenant with Adam demanded God's judgement.

Adam, Abel, Seth, accepted His covenant.
Cain and his seed rejected it.

So now there is a division of two groups of people.

- Even many of Seth's seed joined Cain's group and broke covenant.

The only man keeping covenant was Noah.

- The Adamic Covenant was broken by humanity.

Because of this sin and failure to keep God's covenant judgement came in the flood.

The Adamic Covenant was not cancelled.

- Even by one man it was kept in tact.
- Today we reap the benefits of that covenant because of Noah.
- We can still claim those blessings.

God rescued Noah.

- God in grace protected him and then makes another covenant with him.
- The Noahic Covenant - with additional promises.

Each new covenant has additional promises.

Noahic Covenant:

Genesis 9:1-3 | NKJV

1 So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.

Same thing He said to Adam.

2 And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be on every beast of the earth, on every bird of the air, on all that move on the earth, and on all the fish of the sea. They are given into your hand. **3** Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you. I have given you all things, even as the green herbs.

- Be fruitful
- Multiply
- Fill the earth
- Subdue it (authority over Satan)
- Have dominion (reign)

I'm repeating what I gave your father Adam. Adding:

- [You can eat meat](#)

The Adamic covenant did not allow people to eat meat.

- Adamic Covenant: you can eat the herb of the field.

- Noahic Covenant: you can eat “all” meat, clean and unclean.

“I thought we were not supposed to eat anything unclean.”

- Not under the Noahic, under the Mosaic.

This goes along with what Paul told us in the NT - *all meat is acceptable*.

- They could eat meat accept with the blood still in it.

Genesis 9:4 | NKJV

4 But you shall not eat flesh with its life, that is, its blood.

The reason the blood was not allowed to be eaten is because it was reserved for **God only**.

- He is the only One who can accept blood.
 - The earth will be preserved from a further curse.
 - God promised He would restrain any further curse.
 - God would preserve all creatures from destruction. (Gen 8:21)
 - 4 Seasons were established.

From Adam to Noah the earth had a constant climate.

Watered by a mist from the ground up. (Gen 2:5-6)

Genesis 7:4 | NKJV

4 For after seven more days I will cause it to rain on the earth...

He establishes the four seasons.
