The Bible reveals that our God is a:

- Covenant-making
- Covenant-keeping
- Covenant-revealing
- Covenant-enabling God.

When we talk about covenant-making - God reveals Himself to the hearts of men through our covenant.

- We cannot be His children without a covenant.

We are a covenant people so we have privileges that people outside that covenant do not have.

- The reason many Christians are not receiving what belongs to them is they do not understand the agreement/covenant they have with God.

TL Osborn was asked: Why is it God heals unbelievers and believers?

He said, *"You notice in the scriptures that Jesus healed saint and sinner. In fact, not only are the sinners healed, even the atheists are healed. Why? Because the sinner and the atheist receive a healing as a result of God's mercy, but the Believer receives a healing as a result of God's covenant."*

If the church begins to understand the power of the covenant none in the church would be sick.

There is healing in that covenant.

Let's understand something about God.

- Our God will not reveal Himself to any man till He comes first with a covenant.
- There has to be a covenant before there is a revelation.
- Abel came to God to make a covenant. That is why God accepted him.
- While Cain, who did not come to make a covenant, was rejected.

You make a covenant with God when you are saved.

- When you make that covenant you have privileges promised to you that belong to you in spite of you.
 - Really, they belong to the covenant you made.
 - A covenant doesn't look at how righteous you are, it looks at: did you agree to it.

If you go to the bank and apply for a loan, as long as you agree to the terms you will get the loan... whether you're righteous or not.

- It's the strength of the agreement that will get me the money.

In all 7 covenants God is the originator.

- He's the One with the promises (the goods).
 - We have nothing and come empty.
- He comes with everything and says, "I am looking for someone who will make a covenant with me."
- If you will make a covenant... here are the promises I will make you, and here are the terms.

He is a covenant-making God.

- He will not move, talk, or touch without making a covenant.

He is also a covenant-keeping God.

- Even if you don't keep it, He keeps it.
 - He keeps the part that belongs to Him.
 - He'll keep His promises even if you break yours.

He also is a God who reveals that covenant.

- He is not depending on you to understand it.
- He will reveal it and help you understand it.

This is what you should love about Him:

He is the God who enables me to keep the covenant.

He is a covenant-enabling God.

- So we are not dependent upon our own strength to keep the agreement.

The reason God makes, keeps, reveals, and enables the covenant is so we will understand His purpose for humanity.

- When He came in the Adamic covenant He stated His purpose.

Understand:

A covenant is a binding agreement.

- It has specific obligations.
 - It is binding, it is eternal.
- All 7 covenants of the scriptures are binding and eternal.
 - You are still receiving the benefits of the Adamic covenant. And you are still responsible for the promises your father made on your behalf.

When Adam said, "Yes," he said yes on your behalf. Therefore, all of us are responsible before God.

- That is why man is without excuse. It is binding.
- Someone might say, "*But I didn't know...*" No, God revealed it through His word. Man will have no excuse.

"Well how about those who never heard?"

- God has made His salvation available through the scriptures.

- None have an excuse.

When the rich man was in hell Abraham said to him, *"If your brothers will not believe the scriptures they will not believe tho someone is raised from the dead."*

- What he was saying is: *"They have the scriptures."*
- God will not force the scriptures on them, they are available to them.
- We won't be able to say we didn't know since He gave scriptures to humanity.

So, the covenant Adam made we are responsible for.

- All of us.

The sons of Abraham are responsible for the covenant he made with God.

- Natural Israel
- And spiritual Israel (the church)

We must fulfill the terms to receive the benefits.

It is the same with every other covenant in scripture.

We may not agree with this, but He is God and we are not.

- He sets the terms.

WHAT COVENANTS REVEAL

Covenants do not reveal God.

Covenants reveal the purposes of God.

- God's names reveal God.
- God's covenants reveal His plan and purpose for humanity forever.

Understand something about God:

- There is the person of God.
- There is the word of God.
- There is the person, and there is the purpose.
 - When you know the person... that's salvation.
 - When you know the purpose... you'll succeed here and forever.

The reason people fail, is they don't know the purpose.

- They know God but not His plan.
- They know God but not His covenant.
 - That's why people are in poverty, sickness, or bondage, they have not understood God's purpose or God's plan.

Gods wisdom reveals His purpose and plan.

There is the person of Jesus and the principles of Jesus.

- When you know the person you'll go to heaven.
- When you understand the principles you'll succeed on the earth.

That's why you have saints today who are sick, poor, or bound.

- They do not understand the principles.
- His principles, purposes, plans, and wisdom gives you the power to live from victory.

In the covenants we will learn God's purpose for your life.

- Once we understand it will change our lives.

Every covenant has 3 parts or revelations:

1. Promise
2. Blood
3. Seal

The seal has to do with its execution or release.

- God is the originator.
- Jesus is the ratifier.
- Holy Spirit executes the covenant.
