REVIEW

- This is the first time God gives a covenant to a family.

ABRAHAMIC COVENANT pt 2

These promises were given to Abraham and his **seed**.

- There were covenants given that were only for Abraham and his **seeds** (plural).
- Then there is a portion of the covenant that was for his **seed** (singular - JESUS).

Whenever Isaac and Jacob are mentioned, the connection is **Christ**.

- Christ came through Isaac and Jacob, not Ishmael and Esau.

There is another side to that covenant that we Christians dismiss.

- It belongs to Abraham and his **natural seeds** and has nothing to do with the Messiah.
- It includes **Ishmael**, **Esau**, and the **children of Keturah**.

Remember the angel said to Hagar, *"I will bless your seed because he is Abraham's seed."*

- So we as students of the Word have to divide these two.
- Certain promises belong to the **natural seeds**.

The promises of God were given even to Ishmael, even to Esau, even to Keturah's children.

- Nobody hardly talks about them... we don't even know their names.
- **Keturah** is the mother of the Islamic nations today. (The Arabs)

Ishmael was the son of the Egyptian woman **Hagar**.

- Ishmael's descendants are the entire Middle East. North Africa, the Arabians.
- **Q: Why do you think they have the money and the oil? Abrahamic blessing.**

Q: Why are the Jewish people so smart?

The **Abrahamic blessing**.

- this has nothing to do with the Messiah.
- This is the **Abrahamic Blessing** - the "**seeds**"

Here are the blessings God gave to Abraham.

- We must divide the **Messianic** and the **Natural**.

The Messianic Blessings: (our spiritual blessing - salvation)

- Through Christ we are connected to the **Abrahamic Blessings** both **natural** and **spiritual**.

The "Blessings" of Abraham we receive the **natural** and the **spiritual** in Christ Jesus.

- While His children in the **natural** only receive **natural**, not the **spiritual**.

1 Now the Lord had said to Abram:

“Get out of your country,
From your family And from your father’s house,
To a land that I will show you.

2 I will make you a great nation;
I will bless you And make your name great;
And you shall be a blessing.”

3 I will bless those who bless you,
And I will curse him who curses you;
And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

In these words is the gospel.

When He said,

2 I will make you a great nation;
I will bless you And make your name great;
And you shall be a blessing.

That was personal.

- To Abraham himself.

Then He said,

3 I will bless those who bless you,
And I will curse him who curses you;
And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

In these words is the **Messiah**.

- God gave the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Through Christ the families of the earth were blessed.

The **Blessing of Abraham** later became the “**Blessings**” when he passed the test in offering up Isaac.

- In blessings will I bless you, in multiplying’s will I multiply you.
- This is so remarkable because God speaks of blessing, singular, personal.
- Then He speaks of multiple blessings.
- Then He speaks about one **seed** and then **seeds**.

We must be careful when we read scripture.

- We must look for the **seed** and the “**seeds**.”

THE BLESSINGS OF ABRAHAM

Genesis 14:19–20 | NKJV

19 And he blessed him and said: “Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; **20** And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand.” And he gave him a tithe of all.

Here we see the first result of “ **blessings.**”

1 DELIVERANCE FROM ENEMIES

- Because God has blessed you He has delivered your enemies into your hands.

2 MATERIAL PROSPERITY

Genesis 24:1,35 | NKJV

1 Now Abraham was old, well advanced in age; and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.

One of the things the Lord blessed him with is in verse 35:

35 The Lord has blessed my master greatly, and he has become great; and He has given him flocks and herds, silver and gold, male and female servants, and camels and donkeys.”

= material blessings are included in the “ **blessings**” of Abraham.

3 PHYSICAL HEALTH

Romans 4:17–21 | NKJV

17 (as it is written, “I have made you a father of many nations”) in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did; **18** who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, “So shall your descendants be.” **19** And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah’s womb. **20** He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, **21** and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

- God strengthened Abraham even though his body was dead.
- God renewed his body to produce Isaac and through Keturah, other children.

100 year old man cannot produce any more.

- After Sarah died Abraham lived on, married Keturah and had more children.
 - He lived a really long time.
 - When God touched him he was good for way more than just one boy.

When you say you have the blessing of Abraham, don't forget it includes your physical body.

- **That's why covenant people can claim healing.**
- **Q: Why did Jesus spend the bulk of His ministry healing Israel?** Because they were under the covenant.
- **Q: Why did He refuse to heal the Syrophenician woman?** She was not in covenant.
 - But here faith touched the covenant even though healing did not belong to her.

To this day healing does not belong to unbelievers.

- God heals them because of His mercy.
- No different than God healing the Syrophenician woman... because of His mercy.

Every Christian should be healed for the rest of their life if they live that covenant.

- One day we will.

We are talking about the **Blessing of Abraham** and his "**seeds.**"

Q: Have you ever known Israel to be defeated? Why?

- Deliverance from their enemies.
 - Q: Why would God heal them in Egypt before the Mosaic Covenant?**
 - Because of the Abrahamic Covenant.
 - Q: Why would God give them the wealth of Egypt?**
 - The Abrahamic Covenant.

This blessing even extended to others.

Genesis 12:2 - *"I will bless you and make you a blessing."*

- He said the same thing to Isaac, to Jacob, and Israel.
 - **The blessings on Abraham extends to whoever he blesses.**

So, if you are in Abraham, anyone you bless is blessed.

Q: Why would Jesus say, "Bless those who curse you?"

- Unless you have the power to bless.
 - Q: Why are we commanded to bless and not curse?**
- Because we have the power to bless.

The unbeliever can try to bless others but they cannot without a covenant.

- **When we bless we are backed up by a covenant.**
 - So that makes our words powerful when we bless others.

This blessing will also extend to those who bless you.

- *If someone blesses you* God says, *"I will bless them."*
- Abraham was the one who received the blessing but you are Abraham's seed so if one blesses you, you will be blessed.

When you bless Israel God says, *"He will bless you."*

We are the Israel of God (spiritual).

- The spiritual has just as much power.
- The Israel of God is the church - so it is important to bless the church.

There are two families: the **natural** and the **spiritual**.

Genesis 22:17 | NKJV

17 blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants

God said, *"I will multiply you."*

Even though the blessing is spiritual they come on the **spiritual** and the **natural**.

This multiplying has been fulfilled in more than one nation.

- The nations which came from Hagar and Ishmael (Gen 21:13-18).
- the nations which came through Sarah (Ez 37:15-18).

We seem to forget there are 10 lost tribes still under that blessing.

- Remember when the Syrians invaded the land, 10 tribes were taken captive.
- Then the Babylonians came and took the other two tribes captive.
 - Those 10 tribes never came back.
 - Remnants did in 1948, but not the whole.
 - To this day they are still lost but the blessing rests on them without knowing because God's word in that covenant is eternal.

Children of Ishmael are under that blessing.

Children of Isaac are under that blessing (including the 10 tribes).

Children of Keturah who are under that blessing.

Then you have another group under that blessing... **(the church)**.

4 Nations came out of Abraham

- Ishmael
- Isaac
- Keturah
- Church

Nations will come out of you.

- All these share in the blessings of Abraham
- Gal 3:28-29; Gal 6:15-16 - clearly states this.

Genesis 25:1-6 | NKJV

Abraham again took a wife, and her name was Keturah. And she bore him Zimran, Jokshan, Medan, Midian, Ishbak, and Shuah. Jokshan begot Sheba and Dedan. And the sons of Dedan were Asshurim, Letushim, and Leummim. And the sons of Midian were Ephah, Epher, Hanoch, Abidah, and Eldaah. All these were the children of Keturah. And Abraham gave all that he had to Isaac.

6 But Abraham gave gifts to the sons of the concubines which Abraham had; and while he was still living he sent them eastward, away from Isaac his son, to the country of the east.

Abraham had children by concubines.

- Every one of them received this blessing - in the natural.
- These nations share in this blessing.

Whenever God mentions Isaac He mentions the “seed” and the “land.”

- So, the land doesn't belong to Ishmael, or Esau, or Keturah, it belongs to Isaac. (You have to divide the word)

The **blessings of Abraham** are more than one.

1 **Personal Blessings** - effecting the natural **seeds**

2 **Spiritual Blessings** - effecting the “seed” Christ and the church.

- In that blessing is Isaac.
- So when God says, *“To you and to your seed will I give this land.”*

This blessing to Isaac, through Christ, to Israel.

- That's why there is a war over what? **The Land.**

2 Streams of blessings in Abraham.

- No other individual can claim the blessings given to Isaac, through Isaac to Christ and His church, only the church.

Again, Abraham has:

Personal blessing that affects his **seeds.** (Natural)

- God said to Abraham, *“I will bless Ishmael because he is your seed.”*

Spiritual blessings which effects the physical and spiritual.

- We can claim the **natural** but we have a greater claim to the **spiritual.**
- In that **spiritual** isn't just **spiritual** but **natural** as well.
