MOSAIC COVENANT pt 3

Every covenant: Adamic, Noahic, Abrahamic, Mosaic, Davidic, New and Everlasting... in them we see God's purposes revealed.

Our God is a God of covenant.

- We are the people of the covenant.
- God only deals with His covenant people.
- He has no dealings with anyone outside of the covenant.

He is the originator of the covenant.

- Every covenant has: **promises**, **terms**, **blood**, and a **seal**.

The Adamic:

Promises: ¹Be fruitful, ²multiply, ³replenish, ⁴subdue, and ⁵have dominion.

Terms: Don't touch the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Blood: Rib from Adams side.

Seal: Eat from the tree of life - which he did not.

(If he had he would have sealed that covenant and humanity would have lived in sin forever.)

God protected the seal with cherubim's.

The Adamic revised:

Additional Promises:

- ⁶redeem humanity (the seed of woman - Jesus)
- ⁷Destruction of Satan. (whose intent was to destroy the covenant God had made with man and woman.)

New Terms: faith and obedience.

So, God looked for His next covenant man and found Noah.

- Because the Adamic covenant was broken by Cain who murdered His brother.

God finds Noah and repeats the promises of the Adamic.

Promises:

- Eat meat
- No more curse
- Preserve animals
- 4 seasons

Gives the **terms** of the Noahic.

1. Faith in God
2. Don't eat blood

Blood is shed when Noah came out of the ark.

The **seal** was the rainbow.

- But what God was really looking for was faith and obedience - our seal of the covenant.

This covenant was broken by Nimrod.

Then God found Abram.

- He gave him the promises which included both covenants and added to them.

Promises: Spiritual Blessing

- Deliverance from enemies
- Material Prosperity
- Physical Health

Terms:

1. Faith
2. Obedience

Blood:

5 animal sacrifices.

1 ram in place of Isaac.

Seal: circumcision.

Oath: *“By Myself I make an oath...”*

He sealed it with an oath to be an everlasting covenant.

The Abrahamic included the Adamic and the Noahic.

In this amazing covenant God promises the seed of Abraham, Christ Jesus, would possess the gates of the enemy, and rule forever.

- The seed of the woman became the seed of Abraham.

In this covenant we saw two streams:

- ① The natural blessings (natural children)
- ② The divine blessings (divine children)

We the church are children of Abraham through Christ Jesus.

- We come through the divine stream.
- To us belong, also, the natural blessings of Abraham.

God says the nation of Israel would be an eternal nation.

- He gives Israel promises through the Abrahamic.
- He gives the church promises. These promises belong to the church in Christ Jesus and through Christ Jesus.
- **You cannot claim the blessings of Abraham except through Christ Jesus.**

As the natural seed began to multiply they went down the Egypt.

- There they became a mighty nation.
- They forgot God and worshipped idols.

- Moses had to reintroduce God to them.
- God reveals His power, destroys Egypt.
- The nation of Israel does not discern God as the only God. They ask Aaron to build them a calf to worship.

These were the same people who witnessed God's power in Egypt.

- who heard God speak audibly.
- Who saw fire engulf the mountain.
- Then they said, *"build us a calf."* They were blind and could not discern the God of glory.

When God gave them the 10 commandments they heard His voice and saw His presence in fire.

- They said to Moses, *"We don't want to talk to God, you talk to Him for us. We are afraid of Him."*
- What they were really saying was, *"We don't want to hear God's voice. We will listen to you. Whatever He says to you we will do."*

God took them at their word and gave them the Mosaic Covenant which was a **covenant of works.**

- The Adamic, Noahic, and the Abrahamic there is faith, obedience and grace.
- The Mosaic there is obedience, law and judgement.

Mosaic - obedience born out of legalism.

The Mosaic covenant was given only to the children of Israel.

Paul calls it a "schoolmaster."

- Because they rejected faith and grace given to them by the Lord.
- They said, *"Whatever He says to you we will obey."*

God gives them this covenant to show them the impossibility of keeping it to lead them to faith and grace.

You look at all the other 6 covenants and you see faith and grace.

You look at the Mosaic and all you see is legalism.

- It's **do and live or disobey and die.** That's the covenant.

It is the most difficult covenant to teach on because of controversy and confusion about it.

(The early church had to call a conference to discuss it.)

- Early believers were told they had to obey Moses.
- A conference was called to discuss it - Paul said, *"Salvation is by faith and not by works."*
- Again the Mosaic covenant was given to the children of Israel.

This helps us to not get confused.

- There are portions of the Bible that does not belong to you as the church. It belongs only to Israel.
- So when God says, *"I brought you out of Egypt; I led you through the wilderness; I brought you to the promise land"*...that's ISRAEL. God is dealing with Israel.

Often, believers will claim promises that belong only to the nation of Israel.

- In Christ Jesus **all** the promises made in scripture are yours.
- But, there are certain promises which do not apply. For instance: *"I'll bring you back to your land."* *"I'll bring you back from Babylon."*

Look at the Bible in simplicity.

- The most dangerous theology today is replacement theology. *"We are Israel."* We are not Israel. We are the church and grafted into the olive tree but we are not the olive tree.

We must look at the Mosaic as belonging to Israel.

God brings them out of Egypt

- They disobey in the wilderness
- The first generation dies in the wilderness
- Their children make it to the promise land
- They disobey God after the death of Joshua and worship idols.
- God raises up judges
- He gives them a king, Saul who becomes wicked
- Then David is raised up - blessings come
- Solomon disobeys marrying women from outside and judgement falls on Israel.

There are portions in God's word that belong only to Israel... we cannot claim them.

Make sure the Bible stays the Bible... don't add to it.

- What belongs to the church is clearly stated "in Christ Jesus."
- The promises given to Abraham, Moses in Christ become mine because I see them repeated in the NT.
- This is where we must have eyes to see and ears to hear.

When you begin claiming scriptures like: *"We the church have become a valley of dry bones"* from Ezekiel.

- No, this is the house of Israel, not the church.
- Don't complicate it.

In the Mosaic Covenant God places curses for disobedience.

- **Since you don't want the curses that belong to Israel when they disobeyed God, then don't claim promises that don't belong to you either.**

We are not being brought back to Israel.

This is not pleasant to look at but it's there in the Bible.

Leviticus 26:14-16 | NKJV

14 *'But if you do not obey Me, and do not observe all these commandments,
15 and if you despise My statutes, or if your soul abhors My judgments, so that you do
not perform all My commandments, but break My covenant,*

16 *I also will do this to you:*

*I will even appoint terror over you, wasting disease and fever which shall consume the
eyes and cause sorrow of heart.*

And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

...this continues all the way through verse 46.

God says, He'll destroy you.

Leviticus 26:32-33,40-41 | NKJV

32 *I will bring the land to desolation, and your enemies who dwell in it shall be
astonished at it.*

33 *I will scatter you among the nations and draw out a sword after you;
your land shall be desolate and your cities waste.*

40 *'But if they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers, with their
unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, and that they also have walked
contrary to Me,*

41 *and that I also have walked contrary to them and have brought them into the land of
their enemies;*

if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt—

Then Deuteronomy 27:

Deuteronomy 27:14-16 | NKJV

14 *"And the Levites shall speak with a loud voice and say to all the men of Israel:*

15 *'Cursed is the one who makes a carved or molded image, an abomination to the
Lord, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and sets it up in secret.'*

"And all the people shall answer and say, 'Amen!'

16 *'Cursed is the one who treats his father or his mother with contempt.'*

"And all the people shall say, 'Amen!'

26 *'Cursed is the one who does not confirm all the words of this law by observing them.'*

"And all the people shall say, 'Amen!'"

In other words if you don't keep this covenant you're cursed.
