The Promises of the New Covenant:

- ② Salvation for Gentiles

The 3rd Promise of the New Covenant:

- ③ The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit

Joel 2:28 | NKJV *JOEL PROPHECIED ABOUT THE H.S.*

28 “And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh;
Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams,
Your young men shall see visions.”

Promised outpouring upon the Gentiles.

Acts 2 - When the Gentiles heard the apostles speaking in their own languages...

- The Apostles were unaware that the gospel was now available to the Gentiles.

Why would the Holy Spirit speak through 120 Jews in foreign languages and not Hebrew?

Those Jews were probably blown away.

- Hebrew was “the” language... it was God’s tongue to them.
- Hebrew was the language of the Bible, of heaven, and of the prophets.

Why would they be speaking in a different language?

- Because at that moment, the gospel became available to the Gentiles.
- But the apostles didn’t know it until God had to knock Peter on the head in Jaffa.

Peter has to go to the home of Cornelius, a Gentile, and preach the gospel and was stunned when all of them were filled with the Holy Spirit.

- Because the gospel was given to the Gentiles.
- But the Jews didn’t know it. Aren’t you glad?

So now, the promise of the Holy Spirit is always the promise of the New Covenant.

Galatians 3:9,14 | NKJV

9 So then those who *are* of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.

14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

- So one of the promises of Abraham is the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

- Abraham could not receive it, but you can.

Galatians 3:16,29 | NKJV

16 Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ.

29 And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Which promise?

Vs 14 - the promise of the Holy Spirit.

The Lord said the coming of the Holy Spirit is the **seal** of the **New Covenant**.

What was the seal of the Adamic? The Tree of Life.

What was the seal of the Noahic? Rainbow.

The seal of the Abrahamic was? Circumcision.

The seal of the Mosaic was? The Sabbath.

The seal of the New Covenant? The Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

The next promise of the New Covenant:

④ Physical Healing

The Promises of the New Covenant:

① Salvation for Israel

② Salvation for Gentiles

③ Outpouring of the Holy Spirit

④ Physical Healing

The prophet Isaiah foretold that healing would be offered in the New Covenant.

When did God heal Israel? Some say, when they left Egypt.

- Every time healing came during a revelation of the New Covenant.
- No one was healed in the Old Testament without seeing the cross.

When they left Egypt what did God say to them?

- Apply the blood to the doorposts (speaking of the cross)
- When then came to Mara in Ex 15 God showed Moses a tree (pointing to the cross)
- Numbers 16, when healing came again, the cross was revealed through the atonement - the plague stopped when the atonement was revealed.
- Numbers 21 - cross revealed in the brazen serpent on the pole.

In the Old Testament healing came only as they saw the cross.

- When God revealed the New Covenant to them they were healed.
- If they were healed by a revelation, then we ought to be healed by living it.
- They saw the New Covenant and were healed.

- We are in the New Covenant - so we ought to be healed.

God revealed the New Covenant to them to bring them healing.

- In Ex 12 He said, "*Eat the lamb*," what was that? The cross.
- Apply the blood... the cross.
- Look at this tree... the cross.
- Put the serpent on the pole... the cross.

Whenever they saw the cross they were healed.

- Here are people under the law who got healed when they saw into the future.
- When they saw Christ on the cross they were healed even though they didn't understand the significance.

Remember what Jesus said to Nicodemus?

John 3:14 | NKJV

14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

If the people of Israel were healed when they saw the serpent lifted up, how much more should we be healed who are in the New Covenant.

God wants to give us a revelation of the New Covenant that will drive sickness from our bodies.

- There were no sick people in the New Testament Church (Acts 5)
- They were all healed... every one.
- Peter's shadow healed every one.

Potentially 360,000 in Jerusalem for Passover.

Isaiah 35:1-7 | NKJV *ISAIAH FORTOLD THIS*

6 Then the lame shall leap like a deer,

The lame will leap!

This is salvation; the Lord will come and save you.

- You will be healed.
- This is the blessing of the New Covenant.

Isaiah 53:5 | NKJV

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

"We" - all of us.

Jesus healed the sick under the Mosaic Covenant.

- The law was still in place.
- If He healed under the law, how much more will He under grace?

Acts 5:16 | NKJV

16 Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

If there was one take away we could have from this teaching it would be that our faith would rise and we would understand that we can lay hands on the sick and they shall be healed!

The next Promise of the New Covenant is:

⑤ Deliverance

Total deliverance from Satan and his demonic forces.

- Sadly, today, we have not seen this complete and full as we should; people are still harassed by devils.

Acts 10:38 | NKJV

38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Colossians 1:13 | NKJV

13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love,

That is total deliverance from the satanic.

- Satan has no place in your life.
- You are completely free.
- You have to claim that promise from salvation.
- Satan knows it, but it's time many Christians know it.

This Promise did not take place under the Mosaic.

- **That is why when Jesus came on the earth He was casting demons out of Jews.**
- Demons could attack Jews under the Mosaic, but nobody was attacked under the New Covenant.

Jews that obeyed the law had demons.

But no person had a demon in the New Testament Church.

- You will not find one mention in the book of Acts or the epistles of Paul that talk about demons in Christians.

“My God, what’s happening to us now? “

- We are not living under the New Covenant as we should.
- We have walked away from our Covenant/Cover.

Under the Mosaic, demons could attack Jews.

- Even Jews who obeyed the law.
- Who was Jesus casting demons out of? Not the Gentiles. Jews.

- Why? Because the Mosaic gave no protection from Satan.
- Only the New Covenant gives us protection.

HALLELUJAH!

“Total Deliverance” means Satan can no longer harass you or bind your life.

- If you see a Christian fighting demons there is something wrong there.
- Christians should not have devils.
- *“The devil told me...”* - Jesus said, *“My sheep hear My voice, not the devils.”*
- Why are they listening to the devils voice? They have walked so far away from the Lord that the devil is talking to them.

Know your rights!

- Your rights are: freedom, deliverance.
- How? Get back to Jesus.
- He is the New Covenant.

Your life ought to be so full of Jesus there is no place for the devil!

- So full of Him that there is no place for sin.
- Surrender so that He will take every part of you, then there won't be any space for anything else.

The next Promise:

⑥ The Resurrection of the Body

- No one was raised from the dead under the Adamic/Noahic/Abrahamic/Dividic/Mosaic unless it was the sovereignty of God.
- The raising of the dead took place under the New Covenant.

The resurrection from the dead was released when Jesus rose from the grave.

- That's why all the saints of the old covenant rose with Him.
- There has already been one resurrection... of who? The Old Testament saints.

Matthew 27:50-53 | NKJV

50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit.

51 Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split, **52** and the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; **53** and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many.

So all the old covenant saints rose with Him and did some visiting in Jerusalem on their way to glory.

- When were they raised? When Jesus shed His blood, died and rose from the grave first. Because it says, “He is the first fruit of the resurrection.”
- He emptied Paradise.
- Adam rose from the dead; Joshua rose from the dead, Moses, David, Samuel, etc.

Death began in the Garden.

- Death was conquered on Calvary.

Hebrews 2:14-15 | NKJV

14 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, **15** and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

We are free from death.

- Jesus conquered death, hell, and the grave.
- The resurrection is guaranteed.
- You will rise from the dead.

In Corinth they questioned the resurrection so Paul had to write them.

1 Corinthians 15:20-26 | NKJV

20 But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. **21** For since by man *came* death, by Man also *came* the resurrection of the dead.

22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. **23** But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those *who are* Christ's at His coming. **24** Then *comes* the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. **25** For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. **26** The last enemy *that* will be destroyed *is* death.

- "If you deny the resurrection of the saints you deny the resurrection of Christ."
- He is the first fruit so we could be the second.

Why fear death?

- **To be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord.**

The Last Promise of the New Covenant:

⑦ Eternal Life

Eternal life is God's life in you.

- It is sharing in God's eternal life.
- The eternal One and you becoming one.
- With an eternal relationship with Him.

This was never promised in any other covenant.

John 3:16 | NKJV

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

In this verse God promised life eternal.

- Promised right here in John 3:16.

John 5:27-29 | NKJV

27 and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man. **28** Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice **29** and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.

He said, “I give them eternal life.”

The Terms:

1 Repentance (Matt 3:1-8; Acts 2:37-38)

- “Repent!” is the first word of the New Covenant

2 Faith - by which the promises are received.

- (Acts 20:21; Eph 2:8)

3 Obedience (John 14:15; Heb 5:8-9)

Next we will deal with the blood and the seal of the New Covenant.
